

Privacy policy

What does this privacy policy do?

This privacy policy sets out what personal information about you we will or may hold, and what we will be allowed to do with it. This privacy policy applies to you, because if you deal with us (for example by providing sponsorship or purchasing tickets online) you consent to us holding and using such information in accordance with the contents of this document.

Who are 'we'?

The Data Controller for your Data is Abbfest. We are a registered Charity no 1171953 and we are run by a management committee which reports to the Trustees. More information is available on our website www.abbfest.org. We have a designated Data Controller who is Joe Clowes, our Treasurer.

A number of external Users will be using your information if you purchase a ticket online. Otherwise your information is entirely kept by Abbfest for its own purposes and used by our own team internally.

What Data will we have?

This privacy policy covers all types of Personal Data (as defined in the Data Protection Act 1998) (Data) which essentially covers most personal information that we hold about you as an individual.

We will hold different types of information, depending upon what is provided to us, and what activities we carry out relating to you. The most common information we hold about you will be:

- Your name
- The company you work for (if a sponsor)
- Your contact details including;
- Your email address
- The postal address of your workplace
- Your telephone number
- Photographs taken at Abbfest

What will we use your Data for?

Your Data will be used, held and processed for the administration of or any other purpose associated with or which flows from:

- Your sponsorship of Abbfest;
- That you might be a sponsor of Abbfest;
- Your use of our website;
- Research and analysis or potential sponsors / attendees

- Purchase of a ticket online
- Purchase of a raffle ticket

What will we do with your Data?

We may hold your Data for the duration of Abbfest and such additional period as Abbfest may require for the Permitted Purposes.

We will use the Data, share it between Permitted Abbfest Users, and/or provide it to third parties as set out below as required for the Permitted Purposes.

Data may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area (EEA). It may also be processed by one of our suppliers of online services. We will take all reasonable steps necessary to ensure that your Data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy and any relevant data transfer laws and regulations.

Where will we get your Data from?

We will receive Data either from you when you contact us (including where you provide Data through our websites). In some circumstances, we will receive Data from third parties who provide services to us or to our members. We may also receive Data from regulatory or professional bodies, or your employer. If you buy tickets online or sign up to our newsletter we will store your details to keep in touch via email.

Some parts of our website use cookies to facilitate the functioning of the website and to gather website usage statistics. Further information about the use of cookies on our website and your options in relation to them can be found at www.abbfest.org.

Who will we give your Data to?

We may share your Data among Permitted Users. We may also provide your Data to third parties who are contracted to provide services to us or to you relating to the Permitted Purposes or to our legal advisers, regulatory or professional bodies.

We will also disclose your Data where necessary in order to comply with any legal or regulatory obligations or codes of practice to which we are subject or in order to enforce or apply Abbfest's legal obligations, the terms of any insurance policy or other obligations which you owe to us or a Permitted User or to protect the rights, property, or safety of any Permitted User, its customers or others.

We will not pass your Data to third parties for marketing or promotional purposes.

What rights do you have?

You can at any time in the future ask not to receive marketing or such other materials, including Abbfest publications, information about new products and services

Any Personal Data we collect from the Website will be used in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 and other applicable laws.

Personal Data (name, address, email address etc) is collected when you register on the site such as for a newsletter and also when you complete one of our online forms or purchase a raffle ticket.

Abbfest uses Personal Data collected via the website to update our records, for marketing purposes (such as providing you with updates or details of products and services that we think will be of interest to you) and for the processing of any payments made by you through this website. Members have the right to apply for a copy of their personal data collected via the website and to have any inaccuracies corrected.

We will keep a record of any orders you make through the site (e.g event attendance). We will not retain any of your credit/debit card details however these details may be retained by third parties who we ask to process payments on our behalf.

Unless otherwise stated, we will NOT pass your Personal Data to any third party for marketing purposes.
